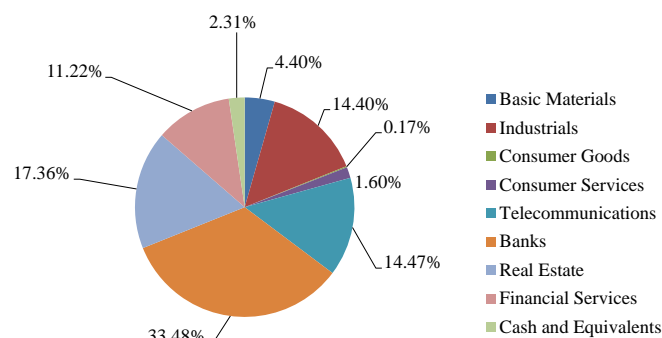
Fund Objective

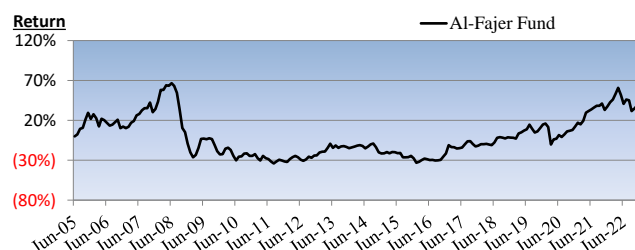
